## IDENTIFICATION

STOCK IDENTIFICATION

The Gilthead seabream is distributed from British Isles to Cape Verde, including the Mediterranean Sea and around the Canary Islands (*FAO 2019*). Several studies on the stock structure have been conducted on the NE Atlantic region and in the Mediterranean (e.g. (*De Innocentiis et al. 2004*), (*Arabaci et al. 2010*), (*Gkagkavouzis et al. 2019*)), lacking the inclusion of the African region.

These two seabream species, *Sparus auriga* and *S. aurata* are grouped by the CECAF in the assessments of demersal resources, thus single species assessment is not available (*FAO 2018*). Therefore, for now, a management unit is considered within Moroccan waters.
